This National Council of Women Award is given in recognition of Women's Plans Foundation and is presented annually by The National Council of Women at its Australia Day Luncheon at Parliament House.

Women's Plans Foundation is a charitable trust advocating the integration of a family planning component in overseas aid programs. The Foundation raises funds and gives grants to overseas aid organisations to enable people to choose the number and spacing of their children, improving community health, opportunities for women and environmental sustainability.

Applications are sought from students with a demonstrated interest in reproductive health who have an understanding of the role of family planning in women's development in third world countries.

The Awardee will be expected to be present to receive the Award at the Australia Day Luncheon on January 25th, 2012, and to speak later in the year at a Women's Plans Foundation function about what the Award is achieving.

1. Applicants must be currently enrolled nursing students.
2. Applications should include a 200 to 300 word account of the student's academic record, and an account of demonstrated interest in reproductive health and family planning as a component of women's development in third world countries. Applicants may also include a resume, outlining relevant professional experience, volunteer work or special need. The application should be submitted electronically, as a Word doc or pdf. Submissions should be emailed to oppenama@bigpond.com and sarah.brown@sydney.edu.au.
3. All entries need to be submitted by close of business **Friday, November 25th, 2012**. Applications that are not submitted by this deadline will not be eligible for the Award and there will be no extension of the deadline.
4. The Awardee will be selected by a panel of members comprising a staff member of the Sydney Nursing School at the University of Sydney, and an appointee of Women's Plans Foundation. The panel's decision will be final.

5. The Foundation reserves the right not to give the Award if there is no applicant of sufficient merit or relevant area of study.
6. Applicants must complete the entry form (see below). The winner will be contacted by phone and/or mail/email and the Award will be received at Parliament House in January 2012, date to be confirmed.

Submission of the application signifies acceptance of the conditions of attending the Award ceremony, speaking at a later function, and being featured on the WPF website.
